### Rules:

**Grades K-5:** To enter, submit an original safety slogan with "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme (one entry per class); artwork optional

**Grades 6-8:** To enter, submit an original safety slogan (one entry per student) about "Safety while traveling on the LIRR"

**Grades 9-12:** To enter, submit a short essay in 500 words or less (one entry per student) about the importance of grade crossing safety

Entries must be e-mailed to [tracks@lirr.org](mailto:tracks@lirr.org) using "Safety Along the Tracks Contest" in the subject line and must include the School's name/Teacher's name, Student's name, address, and daytime phone number.

- Contest is open between **October 1 - December 15, 2018**; winner will be announced **January, 2019**
- Essay Winners will be offered an opportunity to create a Public Service Announcement for the LIRR
- Slogans winners will have their original entry displayed at LIRR stations (where applicable)

## LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD "SAFETY ALONG THE TRACKS" SAFETY CONTEST 2018

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Contests runs on or about October 1 through December 15, 2018. Contest is open to full- time elementary, middle and high school students. To enter: Safety Along the Tracks – Grades K-5, the class will complete a safety slogan with the subject of "Safety Along the Tracks". The safety slogan and/or drawing must fit on a 3" x 12" area. Grades 6-8, individuals will complete a safety slogan with the subject of "Safety while traveling on the LIRR". Grades 9-12, individuals will write an essay of 500 words or less in Microsoft Word format with the subject of "The importance of grade crossing safety". To submit a contest entry, email your entries to: [tracks@lirr.org](mailto:tracks@lirr.org) with the subject "Safety Along the Tracks", your School Name, School Address and phone number, Grade, and Teacher's name. Grade 6-12 students must also include a full name, address and daytime phone number, including area code. All entries must be received by December 15, 2018.
2. Winning entries: Grades K-8 will have their slogan produced and displayed at LIRR stations. Grades 9-12 will be offered the opportunity to create/participate in a PSA (Public Service Announcement) in conjunction with the LIRR to be posted/played at LIRR terminals and social media. The winner(s) will be selected by the Long Island Rail Road. The decision of the Long Island Rail Road is final. Mutilated or illegible entries will be disqualified. Winner(s) will be notified by the Long Island Rail Road by telephone/email by January, 2019. Winner(s) must respond back to Long Island Rail Road within 72 hours or an alternate winner(s) will be chosen.
3. Limit one entry per person/class. The Long Island Rail Road disclaims liability for late, lost, misdirected or stolen entries.
4. Entry constitutes agreement that entrants' names, photographs and likenesses may be used for promotional purposes without additional compensation.
5. Participants must be students and provide proof of school attendance and identity will be required. It is the winners' responsibility to provide proper proof. Employees of the MTA, LIRR, and their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, and their immediate families are not eligible. Winner(s) will be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and release. Failure to execute and return the affidavit and release within 5 calendar days from receipt thereof, shall result in disqualification from the contest and an alternate(s) winner will be chosen.
6. Winner(s) waive any and all claims of liability against the MTA, LIRR and their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, representatives and employees from any loss or injuries arising from or related to this contest or acceptance of the prize(s), including but not limited to, liability for lost, late and /or misdirected mail and printing, typographical or other errors. By entering this contest, entrants hereby agree to be bound by these official rules. All entries become property of the Long Island Rail Road.
7. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
8. In case of duplicate entries, the first entry received will be deemed the winner.
